- Bing Maps (Bing Places listings)

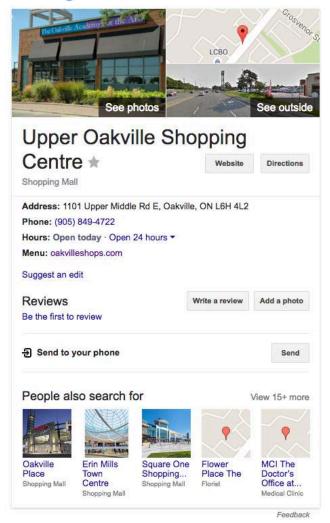

Google My Business Overview

Formerly known as Google Places, Google My Business allows you to put the right info about your business on Search, Maps and Google+ so that customers can get in touch.





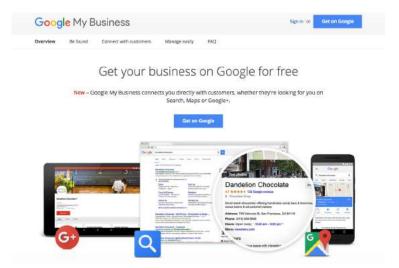
Google My Business allows your company to:

- Be found across all devices

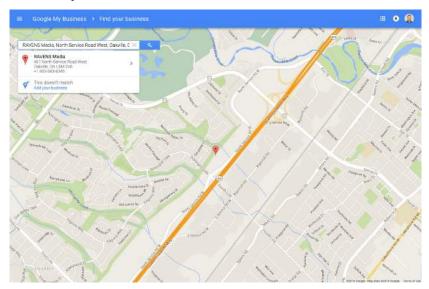
Adding Your Business on Google My Business

Visit **google.com/business** to get started and follow the five steps below to get your business to Google.

1. Go to Google My Business and click "Get on Google".



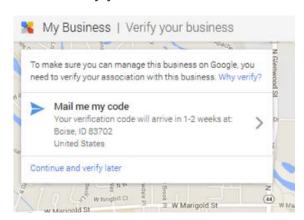
2. Enter your business name and address in the search bar.



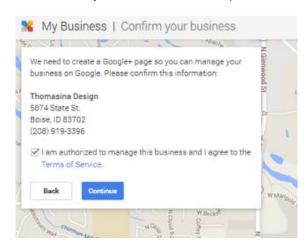
3. Choose or Add Your Business: Click on your business if it appears in the suggested locations. If not, select the "Add Your Business" option below and fill out the corresponding form.

4. Verify Your Business: Google will mail you a postcard within 10 business days with a verification PIN to verify your location.



5. Confirm your business and proceed to set up a Google+ page for it.



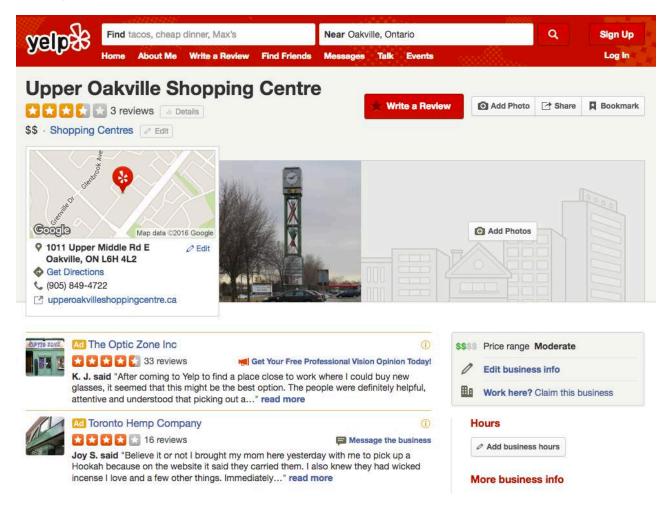


Fill in every field properly and as detailed as possible on your business's Google+ page. This is the information Google pulls from when it indexes its searches. As well, join some relevant Google+ communities and start posting content on a regular basis.

Yelp Overview

Yelp is a website and mobile app that connects people with great local businesses. People use Yelp to search for everything from the city's tastiest burger to the most renowned cardiologist. Get discovered in your neighbourhood.





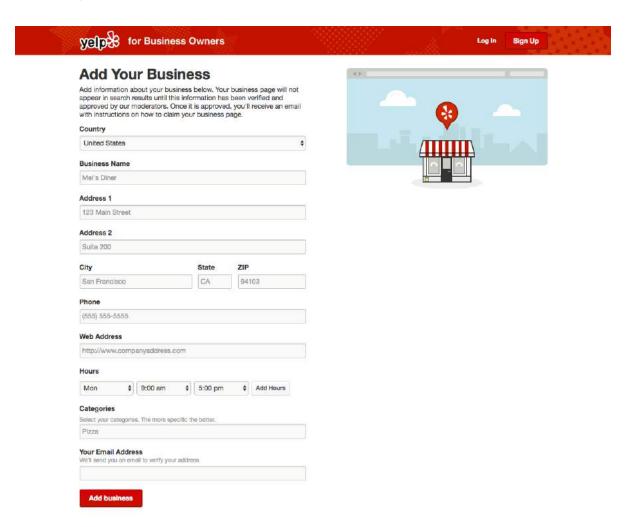
Yelp allows your business to:

Claiming Your Business Page on Yelp

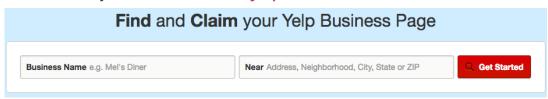
The best way to manage your business on Yelp is by claiming your Yelp Business Page and creating a business login. It's a great, free way to engage the Yelp community.

After claiming your business page, you'll be able to:

- Respond to reviews, both privately and publicly
- Track the User Views and Customer Leads Yelp is generating for your business
- Add photos and a link to your website
- Update important information such as your business hours and phone number

How to Claim Your Business

1. Search for your business on biz.yelp.ca



2. Once found, click on the red 'Claim this business' button.



3. Create a free business account for your business.

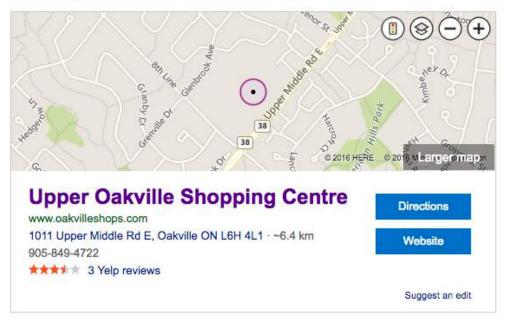


4. To verify that you are the owner of your business, Yelp may call the number listed on your business page and prompt you to enter a verification code. Please ensure you are at your place of business to answer this phone call.

Bing Places Overview

Bing Places for Business is a Bing portal that enables local business owners add a listing for their business on Bing. Using Bing Places for Business, local business owners can verify their existing listing on Bing, edit or update the listing information, add photos, videos, services and other information that shows their business in the best possible way.

Adding Your Business to Bing

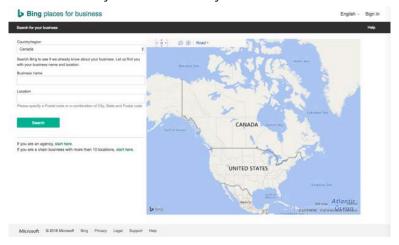
Follow the simple steps below to get your company listed on Bing Places:

1. Go to Bing Places and click on 'Get Started' here: bingplaces.com



Add your business to Bing in 3 easy steps

2. Search for your business by name and location.



- **3.** Claim your existing business or create new business: Click on 'claim business' if it appears in the results. If your business is not listed, select 'create new business' which will make you login/create a Microsoft account and fill out your information.
- **4.** After you fill out all the details and submit, Bing will mail you a verification PIN at your postal address. You should receive this PIN to the address listed within 3 to 5 business days.
- **5.** Once you receive PIN in mail, you will be able to verify and manage your listing. The listing will then be able to go live.
